CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

General

- The scientific committee welcomes contributions for oral communication or poster presentation.
- Deadline for abstract submission is: 29 May 2016. The submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the scientific committee of the conference.

ABSTRACTS

A. Topics for submission:

To allow efficient handling of the abstracts, the authors are requested to submit their abstracts in one of the four following topics and to submit 1 to 3 keywords.

1. New feed materials and security

- Insect meal / Marine resources
- Food waste / rendering / safety
- Nano materials / new feed additives
- Plant products / By-products
- Risk management / Risk assessment

2. Traceability, Authenticity of feed materials including additives

- Analytical methods / Standardisation
- Markers / Fraud
- Geographical / Botanical origin
- Organic / Traditional production
- Risk management / Risk assessment

3. Contaminants, Undesirable substances, Residues

- Analytical methods
- Cross-contamination
- Toxins
Anthropogenic / Endogenous
- Feed to food transfer / Modelling
- Risk management / Risk assessment

4. The industry perspective

- Markers
- On-site/on-line Measurements
- By-products / Rendering Processes
- Biotechnology

- Innovation
- Economical impact / Market strategies
- Challenges

The scientific committee reserves the right to switch abstracts to other topics than selected by the author, as appropriate.

B. General Instructions:

- 1 As only a limited number of oral presentations can be accepted, authors are requested to indicate whether they wish their abstract to be considered for:
 oral presentation
 poster presentation
 oral or poster presentation (no preference)
- 2 Abstracts must be written in English and submitted on-line
- 3 Notification of acceptance will be given by e-mail by 15/07/2016.

C. Abstract Format

1. Abstract title: should be in capital letters, font Calibri body 12, bold
2. Authors: the names of the authors should be in font Calibri body 12, normal and listed in the following order: Last name, First name, Department, Organisation, City, Country.
3. Abstract body: the abstract body should contain maximum 2000 characters and written in font Calibri body 11, normal, single-line spacing.
4. The use of tables, graphs, diagrams, images and embedded videos in the abstract submission is not allowed.
5. Use standard abbreviations. Special or unusual abbreviations should be explained the first time they appear.

Abstract submission deadline: 29 May 2016

Notification of acceptance: 15 July 2016
